HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Tamworth Spartans Volleyball Club is strongly committed to encouraging our members to take part in either training sessions or competitive games and the health, well-being and safety of each player is always our paramount concern.

We are committed to the following duties:

- **Consider the well-being and safety of participants before the development of performance;**
- **Hold the appropriate valid qualifications and insurance cover;**
- **Undertake and keep a clear record of risk assessments for each venue;**
- **Create a safe environment by making sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part;**
- **Ensure that all members are aware of normal operating procedures and emergency for each venue;**
- **Provide access to qualified First Aiders;**
- **Record any serious injuries sustained during club activities;**
- **Discuss safety issues with young players;**
- **Keep a record of emergency contacts and medical history.**

Club members have a duty:

- **To be aware of safeguarding duties and committed to follow all guidelines laid down by Volleyball England and the club;**
- **Correctly use all equipment provided by the club;**
- **Take reasonable care for your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do;**
- **Resist any temptation to take prohibited substances or use prohibited techniques;**
- **Report any unsafe objects that would be at risk for anyone;**
- **Respect and look after all training and playing areas at all times, leaving venues the way they were found.**
